

**Are you a Graduate (GSEC) student who is leaving Lewis & Clark while enrolled in the Student Health Insurance Plan?**

**1. For students leaving school before actively attending the first 15 days of classes for the semester:**

If this category applies to you, you should contact PacificSource Membership at [MembershipStudentReps@pacificsource.com](mailto:MembershipStudentReps@pacificsource.com) as soon as possible after you withdraw. The PacificSource Membership team will assist with canceling your insurance and refunding any premium you have previously paid. If you are leaving Lewis & Clark for a medical reason, please contact Mike Pigou at [mike.pigou@usi.com](mailto:mike.pigou@usi.com) or 503.417.9235 to discuss whether it's possible to retain your student health insurance for the semester.

**2. For students leaving school after attending the first 15 days of classes:**

If you leave Lewis & Clark after completing the first 15 days of classes, you will continue to be covered by the Student Health Insurance Plan through December 31 for Fall Semester or August 31 for Spring/Summer coverage (assuming the semester premium was paid).

**3. For students graduating:**

Insurance coverage for graduates continues through the effective dates for each semester. If you graduate in December, your coverage continues until December 31. For spring or summer graduates, coverage continues until August 31. No coverage is available for non-enrolled graduates beyond these dates.

For Oregon residents trying to find insurance coverage after graduation, [OregonHealthcare.gov](http://OregonHealthcare.gov) is a good place to start.
