





Go, Connect to Server, “smb://papercut”




Mount “Drivers”

“Drivers” and “PCClient”







If you are installing the client, simply double click “client-local-install.app”




Log into the client after it runs. Go into System Preferences, Users & Groups







Go to Login Items, click the plus, and add
PCClient




Print Driver Installation on Mac


Drag and drop the installer to your desktop and run it.




Click “Continue” through this installer




Click Agree



Enter your credentials






Now we need to add the printer

Click IP and copy the settings as they appear in this screenshot


**Address is “papercut” Protocol is LPD
